Students are required to complete two courses, namely BBED1102 Becoming a Teaching Professional: Education in a Globalized Society 2 (6 credits) and BBED2101 Becoming a Teaching Professional: Understanding Learning and Teaching 1 (6 credits), and four other core courses.
